

## Co-Design Workshop: Phase 2 kicks off

Phase 2 of the COVISION Co-Design Workshop kicks off on 18 September, with the young team members (ages 10-16) coming together on-line to continue their work on designs for creative responses to support children, families and communities affected by pandemics and other crises. Sister workshops are getting underway in our partner countries: **Taiwan:** The Taiwan team is ahead of Ireland, with phase 2 already well advanced; **Mexico:** The Mexico team, based in Campeche, is also making good progress, starting Phase 2 on 03 September; **USA:** Our USA Co-Design team, based in Baltimore, Maryland, will start in mid-September, and is planning to hold an on-line meeting with the Irish team early November; **Australia:** The Australia team, based in Melbourne, starts early October.
