


## COVISION Co-Design Pitch Day is Tuesday 01 November

## Co-Design Workshop phase 2: More international partners

The COVISION Co-Design Workshop continues to grow as we welcome a new partner in Campeche, Mexico, who will join the existing network covering USA, Taiwan, Australia and India, as well as our COVISION hub in Ireland. The Workshop team in Taiwan have already held their first event, and the others aim to launch during August. The plan is that we will all be running in parallel by September, so we can share ideas and support each other in Phase 2. The idea is that each country team will hold its own Pitch Day, then all will contribute to COVISION's grand final celebration on 26 November.



## COVISION Grand Final Celebration, Saturday 26 November



The COVISION project started in the middle of the COVID-19 lock-down in January 2021, and will reach its grand finale at UCD's Belfield campus in Dublin on Saturday 26 November 2022. We've chosen a Saturday to make it easier for our young participants to attend, both our Children's Research Advisory Group (CRAG) members, and our Co-Design Workshop team – who are all invited.

The full programme hasn't been announced yet, but here's what we're planning: The event will start around 10.00 am with a COVISION showcase exhibition with refreshments and mingling. The main activity will start at 10.40, and highlights will be the presentation of proposals from all our international Co-Design teams, and a round table with members of the COVISION CRAG. Children's Ombudsman Niall Muldoon will give a closing keynote, followed by lunch for everyone. Look out for the full programme and invitations coming soon.
